We appreciate your patience and understanding as we continue to respond to the ever-changing guidance from the Pennsylvania Departments of Health and Education. As you know, we are in the process of assessing the impact of the latest order regarding cloth face coverings on our family's decisions regarding participation in live, in-person instruction.

We will continue to provide updates to you as they become available and wanted to share some important information today:

1. The first day of school for students has been postponed to Monday, September 14, 2020
2. Weekly food distribution:  
Tuesday, August 25, 2020 will be the last day for distribution at the Pleasant Mount Social Hall

Tuesday, September 1, 2020—all food will be distributed out of the FCR Elementary School (10:00-11:30 a.m.)

There is no food distribution the week of September 7, 2020

Additional information will be shared regarding food distribution for our families participating in the FCR Virtual Learning Network and our hybrid program

3. FCRSD Quarantine Resolution: Please be advised that in accordance with the recommendation of the Pennsylvania Department of Health any employee or student who has traveled to a COVID-19 "Hot Spot" will not be permitted on school district property

4. We do not have the current assignments for our students attending the CTCLC. Dr. Carlucci is working on finalizing the assignments and we will communicate with our families as soon as we receive them. Although our first day is September 14<sup>th</sup>, our CTCLC students assigned to Group B will begin to attend classes at the CTCLC on Thursday, August 27, 2020.
5. Students with disabilities receiving supports and services within an Individual Education Plan (IEP) participating in our hybrid program may attend live, in-person classes five days per week. This applies to all students except for those with speech only or gifted IEPs.
