Dear Parents/ Guardians:

The purpose of this letter is to review the Forest City Regional High School Class Night and Commencement behavior/dress policy with you, as well as share with you the schedule for graduation week. A formal dress policy for both occasions is in effect and is reflected in the following requirements:

CLASS NIGHT: Wednesday, June 9, 2021

7:00 pm High School Auditorium

BOYS: Boys must wear black tuxedos with all accessories, including shoes, provided by Roselle's in Carbondale. No white socks are to be worn that evening. There will be no variations to this dress policy. Full payment for the rental must be made (by paying class dues) before the tuxedo can be picked up. Boys are reminded to bring a change of clothes that evening since tuxedos will be returned to the boy's locker room after Class Night activities.

GIRLS: Girls must wear semi-formal or formal dress; no miniskirts. Prom gowns are acceptable provided they are modest; if in doubt, check with the senior class advisors prior to Class Night for approval. Dress shoes/dress sandals are acceptable, no flip flops or boots.

COMMENCEMENT: Friday, June 11, 2021

7:00 pm High School Auditorium

BOYS: Boys must wear a dress shirt with a collar, a necktie, dress pants, dress socks and dress shoes. (If this presents a problem, advisors will assist students in obtaining what is needed). No western ties, no jeans, no white socks, no sneakers, no boots, no flip-flops or sandals are allowed.

GIRLS: Girls must wear a dressy outfit. Dress shoes/dress sandals are acceptable but sneakers, boots, flip flops or the like are not.

If there are any questions regarding this dress policy, students or parents should contact the school. Violation of this dress/behavior policy may prevent a senior from appearing on stage both evenings. This letter is meant to prevent such a potentially embarrassing event from occurring.

Masks will be required for everyone attending Class Night and Graduation.

We will hold an information night for the parents and members of the Class of 2021 on Wednesday, May 26 at 5:30 pm in the school auditorium. During that meeting we will cover the requirements for graduation and answer any questions pertaining to the information in this letter. It is the responsibility of all graduating seniors and their parents to attend this meeting.


EXPECTATIONS FOR ALL GRADUATING SENIORS:

1. No gum/candy or refreshments of any kind are allowed on stage. Water will be provided.
2. Cell phones are not allowed on stage.
3. Graduation gowns should be carefully pressed or steamed for Commencement. Caution should be exercised because the gown material will melt.
4. Class dues and all other outstanding school debts must be paid in full before students can participate in graduation activities, including practice.
5. Seniors must be certain their lockers are cleaned out prior to June 7th and that all textbooks are returned by June 7th.
6. Seniors must realize that attendance and punctuality for all practice sessions is mandatory. Seniors who are late or absent from practice may forfeit their privilege of appearing on stage for both evenings.
7. There are restrictions on what students will be allowed to have on stage to celebrate their Commencement. These restrictions are necessary for student safety and to avoid damage to school property. Students are aware of what is allowed, and they are expected to cooperate.
8. Caps and gowns as well as tickets for graduation will be distributed during the week of graduation. Extra tickets will be handed out on a first-come, first-served basis.



We want everyone in the Class of '21 with us on stage for both nights.



All seniors must be present and on time for all practice sessions. Students who do not show or who fail to show on time may forfeit their privilege to appear on stage for both evenings. Seniors must realize that their cooperation is vital to ensure productive practice sessions.

PHOTOS

Lifetouch will be taking photos during Class Night and Commencement. The photos will be sold in a group of 4 (all boys in tuxedos during Class Night, all girls in gowns during Class Night, the Class of 2021 in cap and gown before Commencement and your child receiving his/her diploma on stage). Information and order forms for the photos will be distributed to seniors during the last week of school.

TICKETS

Each member of the graduating class is entitled to 8 tickets to the commencement ceremony in the auditorium. Those tickets will be distributed at the end of practice on Thursday, June 10th.

We are arranging for a live video feed of the commencement proceedings to be shown in the cafeteria. As we want the cafeteria audience to be a part of the ceremony, the graduates will process through the cafeteria on their way into and out of the auditorium. The cafeteria will be first-come, first-served open seating. It will not be ticketed.
