Dear Parent/Caregiver:

On December 10, 2015 a Federal education law was signed by the President. This law, the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), requires schools that receive federal Title I funding to ensure that all teachers teaching in a building supported with Title I funding must hold appropriate state certification and licensure requirements, including any requirements for certification obtained through alternative routes to certification.

The law also requires us to notify parents if their child is being taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher in a Title I school or program who does not yet meet the definition of "appropriate state certification."

This letter is to inform you that your elementary school child's computer science teacher is in the process of completing these requirements, and we are providing them the support necessary for success. Your child's teacher is dedicated to the success of every child and has already attained a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited institution of higher learning and is currently completing an approved teacher certification program.
